


Additional rules

It is possible to split regiments into battalions. Strength of all battalions together must be equal to the strength of the regiment.

It is possible to join battalions together back into the regiment. Strength of a regiment cannot be higher than the sum of strength of all battalions.




Polish fighters

Some scenarios allow Polish player to use Polish fighters. The Fighter's counter is placed on the map. It affects all the adjacent hexes.

If German player wants to perform any air operation at any of the hexes affected by the Polish fighters, he rolls 1D6:

1-5 – German air unit is removed from the board
6 – Polish fighters are removed from the board

1 IX

From dawn on September 1, war broke out along the entire Polish-German border. The Germans pushed Polish forces from the foreground and launched an attack on the Polish main forces in many places. All the cities in the area defended by the armies "Łódź" and "Prusy" were on fire. And yet all the transports arrived at the concentration points as planned. The biggest problem of the defenders was the German air force and artillery, which almost always tipped the tide in favor of the attacker.

On the second day of the war, the army "Łódź" began to withdraw from the border to the main defense line (on the Widawka river). Unfortunately, it already suffered some losses and the defense was often improvised.

The "Prusy" army was in an even worse situation, as its troops started arriving by train transports on September 1. Its northern group had to march to its concentration zones during the war and had to take defensive positions while being in contact with enemy reconnaissance units.

The southern group of this army was concentrated in the Kielce-Końskie region, and many sub-units were stopped on the Vistula line or in the zone of mobilization. The army "Prusy", whose role was to counterattack, was unable to complete the task as it failed to concentrate.

4 IX

On September 4, 1939, the German army reached the main Polish defensive line, based on the Widawka River. It was the moment when Army „Prusy” had to launch its counterattack on the German wing, from the Świętokrzyskie Mountains. However, this army was only partially concentrated, and before the counterattack could even start, it had to defend its positions near Piotrków Trybunalski.

The main task of breaking through the Polish positions was given to the XVI Corps. It consisted of two armored divisions. Their attack on Piotrków caused the disarray of the Polish forces and made them retreat at the line of the Vistula River. On 6 September, after making another breakthrough near Tomaszów

Mazowiecki, the Germans already had an open way to Warsaw. In this situation, the retreat of the „Łódź” Army was getting even more difficult and its troops were overtaken by the Germans both from the south and from the north. The Battle of Piotrków is a highly maneuvering battle. The Poles have two tank battalions and several cavalry brigades, but they are scattered on a wide front and, instead of serving in deep areas, they often have to be used in the endangered zones.

The battle near Piotrków, however, has another role. It may affect the overall activities on the front. Skillful Polish defense can slow the Germans down and give other Polish units time to pull back.

Plan „Z”

Hypothetical scenario assuming that mobilization and deployment of all troops goes in accordance with Polish Plan "Z" („Zachód” - West). The "Prusy" Army, with its six infantry divisions and a cavalry brigade is located on the line Piotrków - Kielce and is preparing to attack Germans. Its commander - general Dąb-Biernacki, twice rewarded with the highest Polish military medal - Virtuti Militari, promises an imminent victory.

Meanwhile, German quick units bypass Częstochowa from the north and south and attack towards the Świętokrzyskie Mountains and the Vistula. In this situation, it is reasonable to ask whether the Poles must go to the defense or will they still

want to attack to the west. Taking the initiative is tempting, but is it possible? Strong, Tight, Ready, we always win ... Our Commander - Śmigły-Rydz is with us, and we will burn the barbaric Teutons with fire to the very bottom.

The date of the planned Polish offensive is September 14, and it is correlated with the planned action of the French troops on the Western Front. Germany, fighting on two fronts, will no longer have such a freedom to distribute supplies and forces, and will also be forced to send some of its swift troops to the Western front. All Poles have to do is to hold their lines until September 14.
